ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Since it is incumbent upon the institutions of higher learning in the State of Louisiana to provide educational opportunity in the most innovative and efficient manner possible, and

Since higher education budgets are limited and imaginative methods must be found to effect economics without affecting quality, and

Since the Dillard University and Delgado Community College have as their major mission service to the citizens and residents of the United States, and

Since geographic locations of these institutions argue for close cooperation between the two institutions, and

Since the full and active cooperation between Delgado Community College and Dillard University will underscore for the State of Louisiana the importance of university-community college interactions, therefore:


Dillard University and Delgado Community College do hereby enter into this general articulation agreement.

Dillard University and Delgado Community College do hereby agree that:


1. To be considered an upper division transfer complete 60 transferable semester units with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0; a minimum of 30 transferable semester units to be considered a lower division transfer with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0. (SAT/ACT scores are not required of upper division transfer students.)
2. Programs at both institutions will be reviewed with an eye toward future articulation of other programs leading to associate degrees at Delgado Community College and baccalaureate degrees at Dillard University.

3. Dillard University will guarantee placement as well as college credit for all students transferring to accepted articulated programs after having completed an associate degree and after having followed a specific articulated plan of study.
4. Each campus will highlight the Dillard-Delgado Articulation Agreement in its catalog, and in addition will publish articulated plans of study that lead most efficiently to a Dillard University Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree.
5. Each campus will provide space as needed for a campus recruiter of the partner institution.
6. Each campus will allow for adjunct appointments of the partner institution's faculty based on need, interest, and qualifications.
7. Each campus will communicate announcements of campus events to the partner institution.
8. Each campus will provide professional development opportunities to the partner institution.
9. Each campus will strive to find additional areas of cooperation that will strengthen the ties of the two institutions so that they might better serve the State of Louisiana.
