Merit Scholarships

Dillard University offers a variety of institutional, state and outside scholarships to its students. Freshman scholarships are based on outstanding academic records, competitive test scores and financial need. In order to be considered for a scholarship, please provide all of the information necessary to gain admittance to Dillard by December 1 for the fall term and September 1st for the spring term. Your admittance credentials will determine your scholarship eligibility. All institutional scholarship/grant recipients must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). All scholarships are renewable annually for eight semesters of continuous enrollment. Institutional scholarships do not apply to summer enrollment.

The Dillard University scholarship program is designed to assist students with their direct costs of education and to provide access to higher education at a private institution. All students accepted for admission, who have completed the financial aid process as described above, are automatically considered for institutional aid in the form of grants and scholarships. These awards are based upon both academic merit and demonstrated financial need.

University Scholars

Minimum cumulative 3.8 grade point average on a 4-point scale in academic subjects, as calculated by the Dillard University Office of Admissions; minimum 27 ACT composite or minimum 1220 SAT combined score. This scholarship covers full tuition, room and board and is renewable up to eight semesters. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship agreement.

Presidential Scholar

Minimum cumulative 3.6 grade point on a 4-point scale in academic subjects, as calculated by the Dillard University Office of Admissions; minimum 25 ACT composite or minimum 1130 SAT combined score. This scholarship covers full tuition and is renewable up to eight semesters. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship agreement.

Dean's Scholar

Minimum cumulative grade point average varies on a 4-point scale in academic subjects as calculated by the Dillard University Office of Admissions. This scholarship covers a minimum half-tuition and is renewable up to eight semesters. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship agreement.

Transfer Scholarships

Dillard University offers transfer scholarships to student who meets our Admissions application deadlines and requirements. For fall enrollment, the deadline is December 1st or September 1st for the spring term. All institutional scholarship/grant recipients must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The application for admissions serves as the scholarship application.

These scholarships are highly competitive. The minimum grade point average for transfer scholarships is 3.0. The criteria noted for various scholarships are used as minimum starting points for consideration; meeting or exceeding the minimum requirements will not guarantee your selection. Institutional scholarships do not apply to summer enrollment.

Transfer University Scholarship

This scholarship is renewable based on transfer credit accepted but cannot exceed a maximum of three consecutive years (six academic semesters). This scholarship requires a minimum cumulative 3.80 on a 4.00 scale grade point average and 24 or more transferable hours earned within the last two years. This transfer scholarship covers the cost of tuition/room and board. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship notification letter.

Transfer Presidential Scholarship

This transfer scholarship is renewable based on transfer credit accepted but cannot exceed a maximum of three consecutive years (six academic semesters). This scholarship requires a minimum cumulative 3.60 on a 4.00 scale grade point average and a minimum 24 transferable hours earned within the last two years. The award amount is equivalent to full tuition per academic year. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship notification letter.

Transfer Dean Scholarship

This transfer scholarship is renewable based on transfer credit accepted but cannot exceed a maximum of three consecutive years (six academic semesters). This scholarship requires a minimum cumulative 3.00 on a 4.00 scale grade point average and a minimum 24 transferable hours earned within the last two years. The award amount is equivalent to half tuition per academic year. Recipients must maintain the required cumulative grade point average as noted in your scholarship notification letter.
