### Construction reduces parking 28%

Parking on Dillard's campus, already constrained by more to be removed, has been reduced by nearly a third because of construction projects behind Cook and the Professional Schools Building. As of March 25, there were 302 parking spaces available on campus, down 28 percent from the normal number of 425.

Parking problems will be exacerbated through August, when construction is expected to be completed, according to Keith A. McKendall, assistant vice president of Facilities Management. McKendall and construction workers try to re-orient parking and design projects to limit flooding. Another reason is to complete the work to have the PSH and Student Union certified as "green" buildings. McKendall also said lighting and security enhancements by the end of August are planned. McKendall also said that the construction will be completed by the end of August and that the parking lot will be re-opened as soon as construction is done.

Dr. Tracy Burton (Senior), vice president of Student Affairs, said that the parking lot will be re-opened as soon as construction is done.

## Student population dips in spring

Some 81 new students joined the Dillard University community in the fall semester, according to a report released by the school, which was compared to last year, resulting in 144 new students joined in FY 2012.
