- State homeless education coordinator
- The National Center for Homeless Education (NCHE)
- The director of an emergency shelter or transitional housing program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
- The director of a runaway or homeless youth basic center or transitional living program

In some cases, the individual listed above may only be allowed to make a homeless youth determination if you are receiving his or her program’s support or if, in the case of a school district homeless liaison, you are in his or her high school or high school district. **The confirmation must be on official letterhead from the agency that has deemed you to be an Unaccompanied Youth or Homeless.**

IMPORTANT: If this status does not describe your situation, and you reside with your parents and/or you are unable to provide documentation to support your claim, then you are considered a dependent student. You will be required to provide your parents’ income on the FAFSA. Based on this, you have not met the Federal definition of “Unaccompanied Youth” or “Homeless” and a correction to your FAFSFA is required before we can determine your financial aid eligibility.
