Fall 2024 Enrollment Summary

HEADCOUNT

The Fall 2024 Census Headcount is 1.082 students.

- 1,065 are degree seeking undergraduate students and 12 are MSN students.
- 188 students are New Students (first-time college students)
 - o 181 entered as Freshman, and
 - o 7 entered as Sophomores
- 793 students returned from the prior academic year
- 13 students returned as re-admits
- 71 students transferred from another institution
- 5 students are concurrently enrolled

38 (4%) as Two or More Races;

20 (2%) as Hispanic or Latino;

37 (3%) are coded as International students; and

3 (<1%) did Not Report their race or ethnic group affinity.

All 12 (100%) of Dillard's Graduate students reported their Ethnicity/Race as Black or African American.

FULLTIME / PARTTIME

1,029 (96%) of undergraduate students are classified as full-time degree seeking.

RELIGIOUS PREFERENCE

267 (25%) reported their Religious preference as Baptist, 164 (15%) reported their Religious preference as Christianity, 72 (7%) as Catholic, and 335 (31%) did not report any preference.

COLLEGE / PROGRAM / MAJOR

733 (69%) undergraduate students are enrolled in the College of Arts and Sciences.

150 (14%) undergraduate students are enrolled in the College of Business.

HOME STATE

The majority of Dillard students 596 (56%) list their home State as Louisiana, followed by 139 (13%) from TX, 75 (7%) from CA, and 33 (3%) from IL. 37 students are listed as International.

ACT SCORES – SAT scores converted to ACT composite.

- 57% of NS scored between 18 and 23 on the ACT.
- 87% of NS scored 18 or above
- 45% of NS scored 19 or above
- 31% of NS scored 20 or above
- 15% of NS scored 22 or above
- 12% of NS scored 24 or above
- The median score is calculated as 18
- The mean score is calculated as 19.

- NS mean HS GPA is calculated as 3.30
- 50% of NS HS GPA was 3.32 or above
- 13% of NS HS GPA was between 4.00 and 3.85 [A]
- 22% of NS HS GPA was between 3.849 and 3.5 [A-]
- 31% of NS HS GPA was between 3.49 and 3.15 [B+]
- 20% of NS HS GPA was between 3.149 and 2.85 [B]
- 11% of NS HS GPA was between 2.849 and 2.5 [B-]
- 3% of NS HS GPA was between 2.49 and 2.0 [C+ to C]
