Bachelor of Science/Master of Public Health Pathway



Dillard University in New Orleans, Louisiana, has partnered with St. George's University to offer a Bachelor of Science/Master of Public Health (BS/MPH) degree program. Students in this program will spend the first four years completing their undergraduate studies in public health, health science, or nursing at Dillard University. Upon meeting the

qualifications, students will then transition into the MPH program at SGU's School of Graduate Studies, allowing them to seamlessly continue their education and advance their careers in public health.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Applications to St. George's University are reviewed holistically by the admissions team. The following general guidelines are considered for eligibility:

- Completion of a Bachelor of Science in Public Health, Health Science, or Nursing from Dillard University.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Relevant work experience or a demonstrated strong interest in public health.
- Submission of two letters of recommendation.

ADVANTAGES

- Students enter St. George's University's MPH program directly, without competing for a seat.
- SGU's Master of Public Health program is accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH).
- The program offers specialized tracks in **Global Health** and **Epidemiology**, as well as dual degree options, including MD/MPH and DVM/MPH.
- Flexible learning options are available, with the choice to study online or on campus.*
