## **DILLARD UNIVERSITY**



Dillard University in New Orleans, Louisiana, has joined with St. George's University to offer students an opportunity to obtain a unique Bachelor of Science/Doctor of Medicine degree. Enrolled students spend the first four years of their studies as part of Dillard University's premedical program. Qualified students then proceed to Grenada to enter SGU's four-year Doctor of Medicine program.

## **ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS**

Applications to St. George's University are reviewed holistically by the admissions team. General guidelines for consideration include:

- Upon conclusion of the undergraduate program, students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.4 or above and obtain a competitive score on the Medical College Admission Test (MCAT) within 5 points of the average score for entering students, which is 498.
- All required prerequisite courses for entry into SGU School of Medicine must be successfully completed with a GPA of 3.2 or above.
- Applicants must fulfill all standard admission requirements for entry into SGU School of Medicine, including submission of the SGU application, official transcripts, personal statement, two letters of recommendation, and a successful interview.

## **ADVANTAGES**

- Students enter St. George's University's medical program directly, without competing for a slot.
- Qualified students are eligible to be considered for all SGU scholarships.
- SGU provides alumni mentoring, hands-on clinical skills workshops, and comprehensive information sessions.
- 75+ hospitals and health systems in the United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom offer clinical and ambulatory training for SGU students.\*
